We especially need a digital photo and email address for everyone. If you have not downloaded the directory app, go to the app store on your device and search for "MyUCD". After downloading and installing the app, enter your access code to open the app. In the online directory, you will see photos (if they have been submitted) and contact information for people in our church family. If you click on a phone number, you will be sent to your phone dialer. If you click on the address, you will be sent to Google maps to get directions. If you click on an email address, you will be connected to your email server.

This makes it easy for us to remain connected as a church family.

If you did NOT have your picture taken for the directory, your picture may still be in the directory.

### **Saturday Worship Reflections**

Have you ever tried to share your faith with someone and it didn't go so well? I found myself in this situation when I was at a get-together to celebrate the end of the school year at a coworker's house. Two of my (non-saved) friends were sharing how they like the non-denominational church they attend, and they like the worship music there but they are not crazy about the pastor's messages. I asked why and they gave examples such as how he discusses abortion and how Jesus is the only way to heaven. When I tried to gently respond with the truth they became pretty angry. So I backed off and decided now wasn't the time, they weren't ready to hear it.

The conversation bothered me. I want to see my friends accept Jesus' gift of salvation, I want them to know Him as the Way, the Truth and the Life and I continue to keep these friends in prayer. I know that I can't change hearts though, only the Holy Spirit can do that. I thought it was interesting that the scripture reading in my devotions the next day was from Luke 13:22-30 – the narrow door.

I think my friends are seeking the truth because almost every time I'm with them they are the ones that bring up the subject of faith. I think they want the truth, but sometimes it can be hard to accept when it doesn't align with their personal beliefs. So I decided I was going to buy them both a Bible and give it to them the next time I see them. I bookmarked the gospels for them so they could start there. (By the way – special thanks to Ron who listened and gave me advice about this situation, I appreciate it!)

A couple of weeks later, these same friends and I were on our way to see Pat Barrett, Chris Tomlin and Hillsong United in concert at PPG Paints Arena. Before we left for the concert, I told them I had a gift for them. I was so nervous about how they were going to react. Would they roll their eyes? Would they somehow see it as me judging them? That was not my intention. I really just wanted them to have a way to discover the truth on their own. I was relieved when they seemed excited about the Bibles and commented on how they would take them to church.

Once we were at PPG Paints Arena, I had the mobile tickets ready. We were in Section 211. However, our tickets didn't scan well and we were directed to another line where another employee could help us. I had never used mobile tickets before so I thought for sure something was wrong. To my surprise, when we arrived at the ticket window, the employee looked at our tickets and told us we had been upgraded to floor seats! Wow! Thank you God!

Pat Barrett and Chris Tomlin started off the concert and it was a great time of worship. When it was time for intermission, I figured we would hear the usual speaker from World Vision or Compassion International. I'd been to enough Christian concerts to know that's what happens during intermission.

Instead, the speaker talked to us about a ministry where they are trying to get the Bible translated into every language and he extended an invitation to financially support the ministry. At one point the speaker asked, "Do you remember how you felt when someone gave you your first Bible?" Immediately both of my friends looked at me and I looked at them, all of us shocked. I told them I had no idea he was going to talk about this. Then we were all laughing about how freaked out we were. (Just more evidence that there are no coincidences, only God incidents.)

I saw one of those friends again last week. She told me she read everything I bookmarked for her.

I am learning that sharing your faith can be difficult at times, even uncomfortable, especially if people get mad at you. You can't control how people will react. But for me, it's amazing to see how God is working in the lives of these two friends. And it's also humbling that I get to be a part of it.

I learned the following two songs at the concert, I would definitely recommend making them part of your personal worship time:

"Always" by Chris Tomlin

"Morning By Morning" by Pat Barrett

We will be singing these songs during Saturday night worship, so come and worship with us sometime on Saturday night! Hope to see you there.


