CHURCH DIRECTORY APP FOR YOUR PHONE OR COMPUTER



ATTENTION VOLUNTEERS

All prospective volunteers must obtain the following clearances: 1.

Report of Criminal History from the Pennsylvania State Police (PSP); and 2. Child Abuse History Clearance from the Department of Human Services (Child Abuse). Additionally, a fingerprint based federal criminal history (FBI) submitted through the Pennsylvania State Police or its authorized agent is required if the volunteer has lived outside the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in the last 10 years. Also, all volunteers will need to complete a Safe Sanctuary Training. As a volunteer you can request your clearances and attend Irwin First Church Safe Sanctuary Training at no cost to you.

If you currently have active clearances, please provide a copy to the office no later than Tuesday, May 31, 2022. If you need help requesting your clearances call the office to schedule a date & time that is before May 31st for the office staff to help you through the process. The office will notify you when the next Safe Sanctuary Training is scheduled.

Feel free to contact the office staff with any questions by calling 724-863-6858. Office hours are 10:00am to 2:00pm Monday through Friday. I can adjust my schedule as needed.


