**CHILDREN'S COLLECTIONS:** The Children's Collection this week will be given to Faith in Action (FIA). FIA extends the length of time older adults can live safely and securely in their own homes, by matching participants with trained and compassionate volunteers. Volunteers provide a variety of free, non-medical services to participants: appointment escort/transportation, minor home repairs, errands/shopping, home visits, home safety checks, caregiver relief, and telephone reassurance.

Since inception in 2007, FIA has saved participants, families and government resources an estimated \$22 million.

**CAUTION! CAUTION! CAUTION!** Please use caution when turning breakers on and off in the circuit boxes. **DO NOT TOUCH BREAKERS UNDER PLASTIC COVERS OR TAPE.** Breakers covered with plastic covers or tape **MUST** be kept in the position they are in.

This week our food bank lost several hundred dollars worth of meat and perishable items because the wrong breaker was turned off and the freezer defrosted. Please ask for instructions on which circuit breakers to use when you are reserving the building.

Some tips to remember:





Electric:

- 1. Youth should never be permitted to touch the circuit boxes.
- 2. The humidity greatly affects the light switches in our building. If a light doesn't come on the first time don't assume it is the circuit breaker. Flick the switch several times and it will usually come on.

Elevators:

- 1. Please do not turn the keys at the elevator doors or inside the elevator. The keys must stay in the horizontal position for the elevator to run. Remember it may take several minutes for the elevator to get to your floor.
- 2. Always make sure the sliding doors on the elevator are shut tight. If the elevator won't move, open and close the doors again.

**THE GLASS PARKING LOT DOORS:** We are having trouble with the glass doors at the parking lot. If the panic bar (which is normally down) is in the raised position, the door is locked and the security codes will not work. The door must be opened with a key. All staff members have a key to the building. A repairman has been called and we hope this situation will be resolved quickly.

- ... if you have game equipment (balls, bats, etc.) please feel free to bring it.
- ... lawn chairs if the picnic benches are too hard for you

A short vesper service will end the evening as we experience the beauty of God's world at sunset.
