*I am writing this to seek possible resources to support one of the fastest and one of the most critical mission's in the Mon-Valley that is located in McKeesport. Through a great blessing from the Pittsburgh Diocese Bethany House Academy now has an Elementary School that we call "The Healthy Village Learning Institute". With the most recent killing of a 17 year old and a 15 year old getting shot and injured we believe that we must stand on the front line in protecting the children and youth in McKeesport and the surrounding areas.*

*I have invested all my disposable income into this sacred space and will be paying to have the 2nd furnace up and running to the tune of \$2,348.00 that the Bethany House budget can't fund. Additionally, I have painted every painted space in the sacred space and provided all furnishings (my African collection of Art, Artifacts, and Drums) to create a unique space that can and will promote diversity, In a little over a year of operating we have seen over 1,500 folk come through our doors to participate in various functions and as a result we see the need to expand by preparing the 3 additional floors inside the building.*
