CAMP REGISTRATION PROCEDURE...So you've decided on a camp that you really want to attend, but not sure how to register? Follow these 3 Easy Steps!

The 1st step is to fill out the form located in the brochure or print one from your camp's website. Each camp has an event number, so make sure you note that on your form. It will also ask for a 2nd choice camp event number in case the camp you chose is filled. That's why it's important to get your form in early to be guaranteed a spot! (There is a \$10 discount applied if

you pay your balance by May 1st!)

The 2nd step is to turn your form in to the church office. After Pastor David signs the form, the church financial secretary will send it to the camp along with a church check for 30% of the total cost of your camp. Once the camp receives this payment, you will be registered. The camp will then send you a statement showing the balance due. If you need additional monies, you can ask the church and your camp for a Camp Scholarship Form. There are monies available for anyone that wants to go to camp...so please, use these monies and make it happen for that camper!

The 3rd step is...start preparing for the best week of your summer!
