If you have questions, concerns, or suggestions for ways to improve our church, you may:

1. write a note and place it in the slot in the office door. The office staff will make sure that the committee gets it prior to their meeting.
2. attend the meeting to voice your concerns to the committee. Only committee members can vote on an issue.
3. volunteer to become a member of the committee so you can help improve our church.

Witness (Tuesday @ 6:30 PM) The Witness Committee shall give attention to developing and strengthening evangelistic efforts of sharing of personal and congregational stories of Christian experience, faith, and service; communications; lay speaking ministries; and other means that give expressions of witness for Jesus Christ. Their main areas in our church are: Prayer Chain, Bulletin Ministry (sending weekly bulletins to shut-ins), Sound Techs,

Eucharistic Ministry, Acolytes, Altar Guild, Communion, Flowers, Liturgical Dance, Music Ministry, Nursery, Greeters, Ushers.

Trustees (Tuesday @ 7:00 PM) - Supervise and maintain all property belonging to the congregation so that the ministries of the congregation can be effective.


Finance (Tuesday @ 7:00 PM) - propose, raise, manage, and distribute the financial resources of the congregation to support and strengthen the mission and ministry of the congregation.
