Upholding the Church in 2015 – GIFTS

God has given a variety of gifts and talents to each of us...so what should we do with them? "As each has received a gift, employ it for one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace..." (1 Peter 4:10) God gave you talents to benefit others, not yourself and God gave other people talents that benefit you! God tests you to see how you are going to use the talents He gave you!
